At **Bluegrass Community Hospital**, we spent 2016 exploring ways to advance our mission of making the central Kentucky communities of Woodford and Anderson counties healthier. In **creating excellent workplaces for our 122 employees**, we made **\$331,501 in capital improvements** in 2016, including new OR endoscopes, a renovated Emergency Department with a new glidescope and new equipment and facility upgrades for ENT; and we managed and distributed an **annual payroll of \$6,904,722**.

We are proud to take a **leadership role in our communities** and are committed to delivering needed healthcare to everyone, regardless of their ability to pay. In fact, in 2016 we donated **more than \$950,000 in healthcare services to those in need**.
