At **Clark Regional Medical Center**, we spent 2016 exploring ways to advance our mission of making the communities of east central Kentucky healthier. And by focusing our efforts on creating a place where people choose to come for healthcare, physicians want to practice and employees want to work, our 100 year legacy of caring for our communities is stronger than ever.

**Inviting the best physicians into our communities and supporting them** is one of the most important drivers of our ability to offer the best possible healthcare to the region. During the past year, CRMC added **eight new physicians** in obstetrics and gynecology, internal medicine, general surgery, rheumatology, family medicine and hospital medicine.

And while **delivering high quality patient care close to home** is the single most important contribution we make, there are many other ways we're making a positive impact in our communities.

In **creating excellent workplaces for our 560 employees**, we made **\$10,756,114 in capital improvements** in 2016, including continued construction on our \$15 million expansion of the Clark Clinic, which includes the addition of a second medical office building to house additional physicians and services; and we managed and distributed an **annual payroll of \$39,203,566**.

We are proud to take a **leadership role in our communities** and are committed to delivering needed healthcare to everyone, regardless of their ability to pay. In fact, in 2016 we donated **more than \$1.94 million in healthcare services to those in need**.

We are also committed to **ensuring fiscal responsibility** – both at the hospital and in the community. In 2016, we paid a total of **\$2,025,076 in taxes**, as well as provided numerous sponsorships and donations to local organizations.
